
Years of Experience in Cybersecurity







Hacker Summer Camp

BGH brought 71 people and provided 23 scholarships to help bring recipients to Las Vegas for hacker summer camp, a collection of cybersecurity conferences which include BlackHat USA, The Diana Initiative, BSides LV, and Def Con. Recipients received free tickets and \$1,500 in travel funds and were able to network, expand their knowledge, learn, and see cutting edge research, advances in technology and learn about the cybersecurity field.

CEH Accelerator Program

25 students received scholarships for the CEH Accelerator Program. The BGH Ethical Hacking Accelerator Project is an 18-week program that provides applicants with hands on ethical hacking labs, the official Certified Ethical Hacker ebook, and instructor led training on the Certified Ethical Hacking exam. The accelerated program will provide the applicants with hands on application and use of real-world tools such as nmap, burpsuite, hydra, and wireshark. This training will allow the applicants to see how the tools are used in the work force as well as providing the tools and techniques necessary to pass the CEHv11 exam. After the 18-week program, the students will be provided with an exam voucher that will provide them the opportunity to take the CEH exam and obtain a certification that will allow them to use that certification to obtain an entry level offensive security position.
